Terms: Members of the Adult Christian Education ministry shall commit to one year terms, which may be renewed as desired.

Meetings: Monthly or at the call of the Chairperson

Funding: The Adult Christian Education Ministry Team shall present its annual budget to the Session prior to the compilation of the congregational budget by the Session. Budget items should include such items as:
